



GUIDE TO DONOR OOCYTE FEES

The cost of donor eggs will vary depending on whether you are choosing a local oocyte donor, sourced through our partnership with Egg Donors Australia; or an overseas donor, sourced through either The World Egg and Sperm Bank; Genesis International or Manor Baby. The cost may also vary depending on whether you choose frozen or fresh oocytes.

The below is designed to give you an overview of the costs associated with the provision of donor eggs only.

In addition to the below information there will also be additional costs charged by City Fertility and external providers for the associated treatment costs such as preparation of the oocytes/embryos for transfer, insemination, specialist services, day hospital admission and other associated laboratory fees. The patient services team at City Fertility will provide you with a detailed individual fee estimate based on your treatment plan. If you have any questions regarding your treatment plan, cost of treatment or the information provided to you, please contact our friendly staff for further information.

EGG DONOR AUSTRALIA FEES

The cost associated with the provision of locally sourced donor eggs from Egg Donors Australia (EDA) is as per the table below. All fees below are listed in Australian (AU) dollars and are payable directly to Eevee donor bank upon reservation of the donor eggs.

Once your donor eggs have been reserved, City Fertility patient services will provide you with an individual fee estimate based on your treatment plan which will outline the total cost of your treatment. The below costs relate to the reservation of donor eggs only.

THE WORLD EGG AND SPERM BANK FEES

The fees charged by The World Egg and Sperm Bank an overseas donor bank are listed below. All fees below are listed in US dollars and are payable directly to The World Egg and Sperm Bank and are non-refundable. Please note that once the contract is signed with TWESB you are not able to change the donor selected. Fees are subject to change without notice.

The below costs relate to the reservation of donor eggs only. The Eeve Donor Bank registration fee is listed in Australian (AU) dollars and is payable directly to Eeve Donor bank upon reservation. Once your donor eggs have been reserved, the patient services team at City Fertility will provide you with an individual fee estimate based on your treatment plan which will outline the total cost of your treatment.

Guarantee: Choose any egg donor with frozen eggs already available at TWESB. TWESB will thaw and fertilise the eggs using either donor sperm or sperm provided by your partner. TWESB will arrange for the sperm to be shipped from City Fertility to their facilities in America. Alternatively, if you are utilising donor sperm, it may be beneficial to select a donor from TWESB. Once fertilised, the resulting blastocyst/s will be vitrified and shipped to your clinic. You can select to guarantee either that at least 1 or 2 blastocysts will be achieved**.

GENESIS INTERNATIONAL EGG AND SPERM CENTRE FEES

The fees charged by Genesis International Egg and Sperm Centre are listed below. All fees below are listed in AU dollars and are payable directly to Genesis International Egg and Sperm Centre and are non-refundable. Fees are subject to change without notice.

The below costs relate to the reservation of donor eggs only. The Eeve Donor Bank registration fee is listed in Australian (AU) dollars and is payable directly to Eeve Donor bank upon reservation. The patient services team at City Fertility will provide you with an individual fee estimate based on your treatment plan which will outline the total cost of your treatment.

MANOR BABY FEES

The fees charged by Manor Baby are listed below. All fees below are listed in US dollars and are payable directly to Manor Baby and are non-refundable. Fees are subject to change without notice.

The below costs relate to the reservation of donor eggs only. The Eeve Donor Bank registration fee is listed in Australian (AU) dollars and is payable directly to Eeve Donor bank upon reservation. Once your donor eggs have been reserved, the patient services team at City Fertility will provide you with an individual fee estimate based on your treatment plan which will outline the total cost of your treatment.

CENTRAL EGG BANK FEES

The fees charged by Central Egg Bank are listed below. All fees below are listed in US dollars and are payable directly to Central Egg Bank and are non-refundable. Fees are subject to change without notice.

The below costs relate to the reservation of donor eggs only. The Eeve Donor Bank registration fee is listed in Australian (AU) dollars and is payable directly to Eeve Donor bank upon reservation. Once your donor eggs have been reserved, the patient services team at City Fertility will provide you with an individual fee estimate based on your treatment plan which will outline the total cost of your treatment.

<p>Guarantee Central Egg Bank will guarantee the number of embryos from the chosen program. These embryos are then suitable for transfer (Good & Fair) based on the SART grading system. If less than the number of high-quality embryos from the chosen program have been created and the embryo transfer results in a clinical pregnancy (8 weeks), the Central Egg Bank commitment is considered fulfilled. If less than the number of high-quality embryos from the chosen program have been created and no clinical pregnancy resulted from the embryo transfer, Central Egg Bank agrees to provide additional oocytes in order to fulfill their original commitment – at no extra cost apart from the shipping cost. In other words, the recipient will incur no replacement costs.</p>

ADDITIONAL COSTS

City Fertility Fees

The fees charged by City Fertility with your donor oocyte cycle transfer will be provided to you via an individual fee estimate based on your treatment plan. Please contact City Fertility for a full outline of your fees.

Specialist Fees:

The fees from your specialist will be billed in addition to City Fertility fees. The fees charged by your specialist's rooms will include the following:

- Initial consultation with the specialist
- Planning and Management of the oocyte thaw cycle (Medicare Item 13209)
- Specialists' participation in performing the embryo transfer (Medicare item 13215)

Please contact your specialist's office to obtain a financial quote for your cycle.

Counselling:

In order to access donor oocytes, you will need to attend multiple counselling sessions with a City Fertility affiliated counsellor. The fees for counselling are in addition to the fees listed above and are payable directly to the counsellor. Please contact the counsellor directly for an estimate of their fees.

Medication:

Medications required by the recipient are not covered under the Pharmaceutical Benefits Scheme (PBS). Any medication dispensed will be billed to the patient according to the price schedule of the pharmacy that dispenses the medication.

Storage Fees:

A storage fee is charged monthly via direct debit for any oocytes/embryos that remain in storage. If you do not wish to continue with storage, please contact the clinic to obtain the relevant consent form.

Hospital and Anaesthetist Fees

If your transfer procedure occurs in a City Health Day Hospital/Procedure Centre you will be required to pay \$360 - \$590 (depending on clinic) for hospital admission and bed fees on the day of your transfer procedure. If your treatment plan includes a TESA procedure additional hospital and anaesthetist fees will apply. Please contact the clinic for an estimate of these fees.

Cancelled Cycles

If your oocyte thaw cycle is cancelled at any stage of treatment there will be a cancellation fee payable. If you have commenced your cycle, you may be eligible for a Medicare rebate. The initial registration fee is non-refundable. Any medication dispensed by the pharmacy is also non-refundable and is not covered by the cancellation fee.
